Aim of the Workshop

The overarching objective of the workshop is to focus on latest developments in adaptation Monitoring & Evaluation (M&E) at national level mostly in Europe. It looks into countries that have gained practical experience in monitoring, using quantitative and qualitative indicators and evaluating their national adaptation strategies (NAS) and national adaptation plans (NAP) to share their lessons learnt and discuss their approaches to commonly faced challenges with Turkish colleagues.

The main objective of the workshop is to support efforts to increase domestic climate change resilience through adaptation planning and actions. The workshop aims at raising the awareness for the need for adaptation and provide a platform for exchanging experience and taking stock of recent developments on, and potential for future deployment of climate change adaptation policy, focusing on Monitoring, Indicators and Evaluation.
