The main objective of the workshop is to inform participants about and to provide a soft training on reporting requirements on adaptation based on the Energy Union Governance Regulation. Further, it will be explained how this reporting is linked to adaptation policy development along the adaption policy cycle, using the Adaptation Support Tool (AST).

Member State representatives will share their experiences about their reporting efforts and how the information was compiled in order to fulfill reporting requirements. In addition, learning from the first reporting cycle will be shared with the participants from the beneficiary region.

The training provided in this workshop follows the logic of the different steps of the adaptation policy cycle and aim at supporting the development and implementation of adaptation policies in and ensuring a sound connection to the new EU Strategy on Adaptation to Climate Change (COM(2021) 82), published on February 24, 2021.
